THINK OF IT AS A "C MINOR" SWINGING BLUES WITH CHANGES THAT ARE FAR MORE INTERESTING THAN THE NORMAL BLUES CHORD PROGRESSIONS!  
NOTICE IN MEASURE 7 THERE ARE TEMPORARY MODULATION CHORDS FOR ONE MEASURE THAT ALSO HELPS TO PRODUCE MORE CHROMATICISM.
